Principal's Report Dr. Jean Schoenlank

- A. Thank you
 - Dr Schoenlank expressed appreciation for the kind words. Is a bittersweet time to be leaving a school she loves so much.
- B. Welcome to the New Executive Board.
 - Dr. Schoenlank welcomed the new Executive Board and thanked them for dedicating their time to support Ridge School.
- C. **Friends of Ridge** Dr. Schoenlank discussed Friends of Ridge and the many activities that are supported by the generous donations made through the Campaign. Enrichment activities like monthly read aloud for ROC assemblies, author visits from Cheryl Wills and

- Ruby Bridges, Mad Science assemblies, and grade level activities like The Encampment and Kindergarten Chicks were all made possible this year by Friends of Ridge.
- D. **Teacher of the Year** Dr. Schoenlank announced the Teacher of the Year recipients for this year: Danielle Vandervelt (1st Grade Teacher) and Colleen Manke. There will be a ceremony at Benjamin Franklin Middle School on Tuesday, June 15th at 7pm.

E. Staff Updates

- Ridge School will have a full time Guidance Counselor for the next school year.
 Pending final approval, Lindsay Mitchell (5th Grade Teacher at Ridge) will assume this role next year.
- Lindsay Rubin will become the full time Guidance Counselor at Orchard School.
- On Thursday, June 10th, the new principal of Ridge School will be announced.
- Grade level teacher changes include the following:
 - o 3, Kindergarten classes led by Ms. Blatt, Ms. Carroll, and Ms. Poulis.
 - 3, 3rd Grade classes led by Ms. Banchitta, Ms. Kimbell, and Ms. Kowalski/Ms. Sullivan (Ms. Sullivan will remain on LOA until January 2021).
 - 3, 5th Grade classes led by Ms. Marmo (former 4th grade teacher) and Ms. McDermott.
 - o Mr. Tarulli (5th grade teacher) will teach 4th grade.
 - Ms. Jarosz will return as a 2nd grade teacher.
 - Staff assignments are changing daily. An update will be communicated in the coming days.
 - New principal will be involved in the formation of classes.
- F. **Step Up Day**, a tradition where students find out their next year's teacher on the last day of school, will not happen this year. Last year changes were required to accommodate the hybrid/remote models. To avoid potential confusion and disappointment, parents will be notified of teacher assignments in August 2021. Plan is to eventually return to the traditional Step Up Day.
- G. **Summer Reader** Dr. Schoenlank discussed plans for keeping children engaged in reading over the summer. A major priority, she has been visiting each class to discuss the importance of making plans for reading over the summer. Much like the muscles in your body, if you don't use it, you lose it! Ten weeks is a long time. Encouraging students and parents to come up with a summer reading plan to keep kids engaged in reading.
