

Halloween at Ridge- 2018

Wednesday, October 31, is Halloween. In the afternoon, Ridge students have the opportunity to dress in their favorite costumes and parade around the school in our annual Halloween Parade. Parents are invited to view the parade from the front of the school beginning at 1:00pm. Understanding that some families prefer that their children not participate in this activity, please know that dressing in costume is optional and at the discretion of individual families. For students who choose not to participate, an alternate activity will be available.

For the school parade, children must avoid costumes and masks that are gruesome and violent and children are not permitted to bring fake weapons to school. We encourage positive choices for costumes.

There will be just one lunch period on Halloween for all students, from 12:00 - 12:45.

This is 10 minutes earlier than our usual time in order to give us enough time for our afternoon activities. Many Ridge students choose to go home for lunch in order to get into their costumes. Remember to write a lunch note if you plan on having your child go home. Children who stay at Ridge for lunch will be given time to change into costumes. Also, as you can imagine, the pick-up and drop-off area is very busy. Please follow the red zone rules. If you are going to attend the parade, plan to park on the street and walk to the school.
