TRAVEL BASEBALL & SOFTBALL NOTES: This year, as in years past, anyone interested in participating on a Travel team must register for TRAVEL BALL TRYOUTS as part of your Rec Registration in order to be considered for the program. Tryout dates are posted at

www.rbsa.us under Travel Baseball and will begin in early January. A non-refundable \$30 administrative fee for all tryout registrants helps offset expenses associated with the tryout process. You must register for a Spring Recreation program in order to be eligible for these programs.

Special Note To Parents of 5th graders and above--Rec and Travel:

Prior to registering for Baseball or Softball, we ask that you consider the ramifications of your child playing multiple in-season sports at the same time. Inevitably the conflicts of playing two spring sports on multiple days per week will arise, and your child will miss both practices and games of at least one sport. Missing practices and games is not fair to your child's teammates or their volunteer coaches, who have spent time and effort to draft both recreational and travel teams. For this reason we ask that you give serious consideration to registering for only one spring sport.

Special note: Spring recreational Softball is available to all girls in 1st through 9th grade.
