There will be 4 sections in both Kindergarten and 1st grade; There will be 3 sections in grades 2, 3, 4, and 5.

Threshold numbers for each grade:

- 22 children for grades K and 1
- 24 children for grade 2
- 25 children for grades 3, 4, and 5.

Questions from the audience to Jean:

- 1. How do you adjust if we have more kids than the threshold for a grade?

 <u>Jean</u>: We might have to open up another classroom. Regarding class size, Jean noted that our teachers are talented, and they can adjust to the fluctuating number of kids. It is the teacher that matters more than the class size. Jean tries to spread out the teacher assistants among the classes, but they are really there to help certain children. Jean tries to be as thoughtful as possible to make the classroom equitable.
- 2. Are other schools as tight as we are?

 <u>Jean</u>: Orchard has same guidelines. Their threshold is over 50. As soon as they hit 52 children, they get a third section.
- Could we rezone based on numbers since Orchard is so small?
 <u>Jean:</u> This is a question that parents need to ask the Board of Education.
 Willard is the biggest school; Ridge is the second biggest. We have 450 students this year.

Every child who attends Ridge will count towards our numbers. Most of our kids are mainstreamed.
